



NOVENA TO OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE WITH CARDINAL BURKE



Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest Living the Truth in Charity

Dear Faithful Friends of the Institute of Christ the King,

This year marks the 20th anniversary of the Institute offering summer camps in the United States for the spiritual, intellectual, and moral formation of young people. In that time, this apostolate has seen steady growth. From 15 boys in 2004 to recently over 450 boys and girls ages 9-17 participating each year, we have reached the point where this work of formation requires a permanent home. I am excited to share that the Sacred Heart Retreat Center in Burlington, WI will be the new location for this year's Summer Youth Camps. The property boasts sufficient land for youth activities, comfortable future lodging, space for prayer and recollection, and a large chapel. Our camps will be able to expand in the coming years with this new addition, but we need your help.

With some clearing and landscaping, the 100 acres of beautiful grounds can be put to its intended use: sports and games for our youth. Removing brush and debris from the groups, restoring and expanding of the path system in the woods, and renovating the existing detached buildings into bath, shower, and kitchen facilities for our youth camps is budgeted to cost \$150,000. This project is already underway. We aim to have it completed by this summer, in time to welcome our youth with a camp experience like never before.

I invite you to join us again this year for seven days of interactive programs, daily Holy Mass, and invaluable opportunities for your children to form lifetime friendships.
