Dear Faithful and Friends of Saint Patrick Oratory,

**From September 28 - November 6, 2022, Saint Patrick Oratory has chosen to host and organize 40 Days for Life. This will be the very first 40 Days for Life in Waterbury.** This is a momentous opportunity for many prayers and sacrifices after the post-Roe era. Defending life, and especially the lives of the unborn, is truly not optional for us Catholics and not to be left to the sole responsibility of a few people, which is why it is very important that we all join other Catholics for 40 Days for Life – 40 days of prayer and fasting for an end to abortion. We will be reaching out to our neighboring churches such as Waterbury's mother church of the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception to help us with this great endeavor that cannot be ignored.

All faithful are also invited to stand and peacefully pray during this 40-day vigil on the sidewalk in front of the Waterbury Planned Parenthood abortion mill at 617 Watertown Ave, Waterbury CT 06708, and also to help spread the word about this important community outreach. The vigil will take place Mondays - Saturdays, 7am - 7pm.
