SANCTUARY LAMP INTENTIONS

The Tabernacle Veil covers the Tabernacle Doors of the Blessed Sacrament. It is the primary visible sign and reminder to us of the Real Presence of Christ. In addition to this primary visible sign, there is a second visible sign and reminder, a Sanctuary Lamp, that burns day and night to stand vigil to Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. Each week, the Sanctuary Lamp is available to memorialize a deceased person or for a special intention. You may sponsor the burning of the lamp per week by submitting your intention and offering (recommended offering is \$20) to the priory office.

Sunday, Feb. 19, 1st day of 40 Hours

After 8am Low Mass, Blessed Sacrament is exposed; additional 6pm High Mass, & Eucharistic Adoration continues until Benediction at 11:30pm

Tuesday, Feb. 21, 3rd day of 40 Hours

After 8am Low Mass, Blessed Sacrament is exposed; additional 6pm High Mass followed by Eucharistic Procession, Benediction & Conclusion of 40 Hours
