OCTAVE DAY OF CHRISTMAS
THE CIRCUMCISION OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST

Introit: Is. 9, 6. A Child is born to us, and a son is given to us: Whose government is upon His shoulder: and His name shall be called the angel of great counsel. **Ps. 97, 1.** Sing ye to the Lord a new canticle: because He hath done wonderful things. *V.* Glory.

Collect: O God, Who, by the fruitful virginity of blessed Mary, hast bestowed upon mankind the rewards of eternal salvation, grant, we beseech Thee, that we may evermore experience the intercession in our behalf of her through whom we have been found worthy to receive the author of life, Our Lord Jesus Christ, Thy Son, Who with Thee.

Epistle: Titus 2, 11-15. Dearly beloved, the grace of God our Saviour hath appeared to all men, instructing us, that denying ungodliness and worldly desires, we should live soberly, and justly, and godly in this world, looking for the blessed hope and coming of the glory of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ, Who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from all iniquity, and might cleanse to Himself a people acceptable, a pursuer of good works. These things speak, and exhort: in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Gradual: Ps. 97, 3, 4, 2. All the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God: sing joyfully to God all the earth. *V.* The Lord hath made known his salvation: He hath revealed His justice in the sight of the gentiles.

Alleluia, alleluia. *V.* **Heb. 1, 1-2.** God, Who diversely spoke in times past to the fathers by the prophets, last of all in these days hath spoken to us by His Son. Alleluia.

Gospel: Luke 2, 21. At that time, after eight days were accomplished that the child should be circumcised, His name was called Jesus, which was called by the angel, before He was conceived in the womb.

Offertory: Ps. 88, 12, 15. Thine are the heavens and Thine is the earth: the world and the fullness thereof Thou hast founded; justice and judgment are the preparation of Thy throne.

Secret: Accept our offerings and prayers, we beseech Thee, O Lord; cleanse us by Thy heavenly mysteries and graciously hear us. Through our Lord.

Preface of the Nativity: It is truly meet and just, right and availing unto salvation, that we should in all times and in all places give thanks unto Thee, O holy Lord, Father almighty and everlasting God. Because by the mystery of the Word made flesh, the light of Thy glory hath shone anew upon the eyes of our mind: that while we acknowledge Him to be God seen by men, we may be drawn by Him to the love of things unseen. And therefore with angels and archangels, with thrones and dominions, and with all the heavenly hosts, we sing a hymn to Thy glory, saying without ceasing: *Holy, holy, holy . . .*

Communion: Ps. 97, 3. All the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God.

Postcommunion: May this communion, O Lord, cleanse us from sin and, by the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God, make us partakers of the heavenly remedy. Through the same.

FOURTH CENTENARY OF ST. FRANCIS DE SALES

On December 28, 1622, the exiled bishop and prince of Geneva was serving on a diplomatic mission when he fell ill and died at the Monastery of the Visitation in Lyons, France. He was canonized in 1665 and proclaimed Doctor of the Universal Church in 1877. His feast was fixed on January 29.

The fourth centenary of his heavenly birthday is the occasion for us to prepare for his feast at the end of this month and dedicate this entire calendar year to the veneration, invocation, and imitation of the saint who is our spiritual master in the Institute of Christ the King.

The American Province will prepare for his feast with a novena from January 20-28. As his feast falls this year on a Sunday, we will be able to keep it with special solemnity. We look forward to holding additional events in the coming year to help you learn all that the great Doctor of Charity has to offer you for the growth of your spiritual life.
