Courses are subject to cancellation if there is low enrollment. You do not have to be a registered Shrine parishioner in order to enroll in Infant King Co-Op classes.

PROVINCIAL SHRINE

Phase 2 scheduled to begin

Having received the city permits after waiting nearly 300 days during last year's shut-down, we are now eager to begin Phase II of building our Provincial Shrine of Christ the King as the Institute's Headquarters in the United States.

Thanks to the generosity and enthusiasm of thousands of benefactors, who desire to visibly honor our Lord Jesus Christ as King in our nation today, we are able to begin the first part of Phase II construction!

Part 1 of Phase II will provide a 6" thick, structural concrete slab to the church's narthex, nave, sanctuary, and basement as a foundation for the subsequent steps in Phase II. This scope of work includes the excavation and grading of the present interior, installation of utility services, the routing and installation of all electrical conduit in the floor (in preparation for subsequent running of electrical wires), the routing and installation of all interior plumbing systems, and the installation of the radiant heating system into the floor prior to pouring the massive concrete slab.
