In addition, Mass intention requests must now be accompanied with the stipend in order for the requests be actually reserved & scheduled in the Mass intention book. Dear faithful,

On November 18th we will be celebrating the feast of the dedication of the basilicas of Saints Peter and Paul. This feast combines the standard celebration of the dedication of a church for St. Peter's Basilica and the Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls, which were both built by the Emperor Constantine the Great during the 4th century. These sites had already been visited by pilgrims for over a century when the basilicas were built to honor the apostles traditionally believed to have been buried there. The basilicas were originally joined by a colonnade, which was built despite the distance of several miles between them.

Their significance in the Church is emphasized in the reference made to them in the obligation on Catholic bishops to make a visit ad limina in which they are required to go "to the tombs of the Apostles" in Rome every five years to report on the status of their dioceses.

The feast of a dedication of a church commemorates annually its consecration by the bishop, by which he solemnly renders it worthy of the august sacrifice which will take place in it. Let us continue to pray that soon we will be able to experience that beautiful ceremony in our own beloved Shrine!
