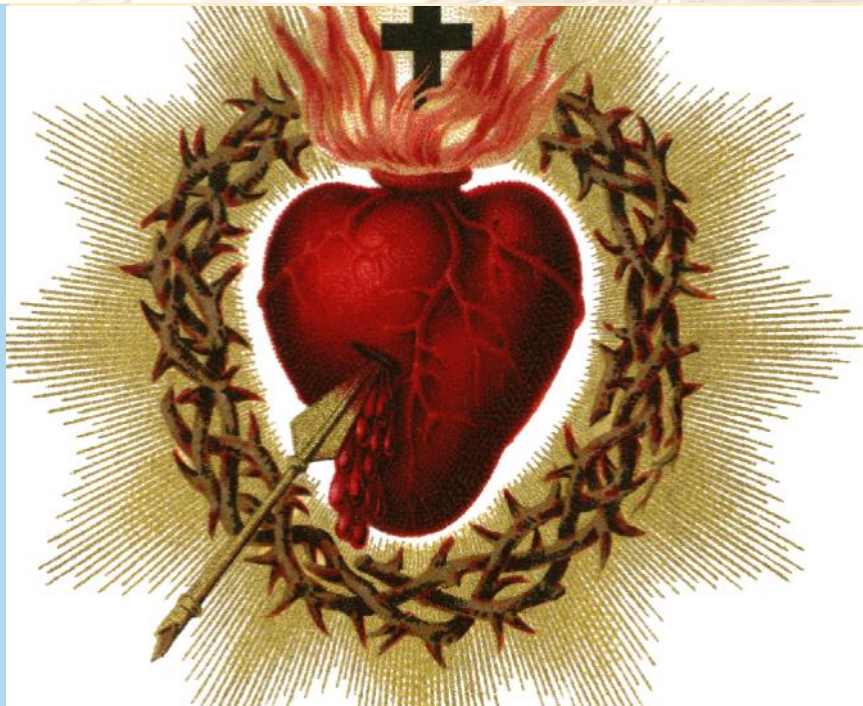

Word from the Vice-Rector

Dear Faithful,

A Happy Father's Day to each and every father among you! Fatherhood in our society is under attack today like never before. It is run down, ridiculed, perverted, and otherwise destroyed by the powers that be. Yet we know that all fatherhood comes from God, Who is the Father of all, and first of all of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Saint Paul says in his epistle to the Ephesians, "For this cause I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, of whom all paternity in heaven and earth is named." Human fathers have the great honor to reflect in a small yet real way the divine paternity of God the Father.

They are the "high priest" in their family, called to raise their children in love and fear of God and His commandments. The Holy Spirit tells us in the Bible that, "The father of the just rejoiceth greatly: he that hath begotten a wise son, shall have joy in him." [Proverbs 23:24] If a father practices his faith, prays with his family, loves and corrects his children, and most of all gives them a good example by his own life, they are likely to follow him in the path of virtue and goodness. If a father rarely practices his faith, stays away from the sacraments, does not correct his children while there is still time, is it any surprise if they abandon the faith later on? Be courageous men. Your souls and the souls of your wife and children depend upon it. Let your motto be these words found in the book of Joshua, "But as for me and my house we will serve the Lord."
