## "OCTOBER" PRAYER TO ST. JOSEPH


*Pope Leo XIII decreed that this prayer be recited each day during the month of October after the recitation of the holy rosary*

### 22<sup>nd</sup> Sunday After Pentecost

#### Introit

#### Epistle

*Philippians I, 6-11*

Brethren: We are confident in the Lord Jesus that He Who has begun a good work in you will bring it to perfection until the day of Christ Jesus. And I have the right to feel so about you all, because I have you in my heart, all of

you, alike in my chains and in the defense and confirmation of the Gospel, as sharers in my joy. For God is my witness how I long for you all in the heart of Christ Jesus. And this I pray, that your charity may more and more abound in knowledge and all discernment, so that you may approve the better things, that you may be upright and without offense unto the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of justice, through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

### Gradual & Alleluia

Behold how good it is, and how pleasant where brethren dwell as one! It is as when the precious ointment upon the head runs down over the beard, the beard of Aaron.

Alleluia, alleluia. They that fear the Lord, let them hope in Him. He is their helper and protector. Alleluia.

### Gospel

*Matthew XXII, 15-21*

At that time, the Pharisees went and took counsel how they might trap Jesus in His talk. And they sent to Him their disciples with the Herodians, saying, Master, we know that You are truthful, and that You teach the way of God in truth, and that You care naught for any man; for You do not regard the person of men. Tell us, therefore, what do You think: Is it lawful to give tribute to Caesar, or not? But Jesus, knowing their wickedness, said, Why do you test Me, you hypocrites? Show Me the coin of the tribute. So they offered Him a denarius. Then Jesus said to them, Whose are this image and the inscription? They said to Him, Caesar's. Then He said to them, Render, therefore, to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's.
