MASS TIME CHANGE

Beginning on Ash Wednesday March 2nd, there will be a change to some of our weekday Mass times. Holy Mass on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday will now be offered at 7:45 am with Confession at 7:15 am. There will still be the evening Mass on Tuesdays with devotions to Our Lady of Perpetual Help. On First Fridays, however, we will keep our existing schedule of Mass at 6:00 p.m. followed by Holy Hour.

SACRAMENTS

We have finally confirmed with the Bishop's office that October 29th will be the date for the conferral of the Sacrament of Confirmation by His Excellency.

Confirmation classes will begin in the month of March. Classes will take place on the 2nd and 4th Saturday of the month, unless otherwise noted. The first class will take place at 9:00 am on March 13th.

First Holy Communion will take place on June 19. Parents with children who are 7 years old, please use the sign up sheet in the back.
