By Church law, in order to be a practicing Catholic, it is necessary to confess one's grave sins at least once a year (canon 989) and to receive Holy Communion at least once a year, during the Easter season (canon 920), counted between the First Sunday of Lent and Trinity Sunday.

In the Middle-Ages, it was called Close-Pasch, no doubt in allusion to its being the last day of the Easter Octave. Such is the solemnity of this Sunday, that not only is it of a Greater Double rite, but no Feast, however great, can ever be kept upon it."

Notice from the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph
