A few reminders for the reception of Holy Communion:

- Please use the Communion Cloth (houseing cloth). Place both hands underneath the cloth and form a "tray" underneath.
- The communicant does not respond "Amen".
- **Please do not** line up in front of the first pew to wait for the kneeling communicants to receive. Rather, wait in the main aisle and fill each spot that is emptied. This is for multiple reasons; one of them being to allow a greater ease of movement, most especially when there is more than one priest distributing Holy Communion.
