CONFIRMATION CATECHISM

The months of June and July will be serve as our “summer break” for Confirmation catechism. Students are still encouraged to go over the material, most especially any items which require memorization, during this time.

EASTER DUTY

By Church law, in order to be a practicing Catholic, it is necessary to confess one’s grave sins at least once a year (canon 989) and to receive Holy Communion at least once a year, during the Easter season (canon 920), counted between the First Sunday of Lent and Trinity Sunday.

FLOWERS, MONTH OF MAY

Empty vases are available all month in front of the statue of our Lady so that you can bring fresh flowers in honor of Our Blessed Mother, Queen of the May.

O Mary conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee!

RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

A few reminders for the reception of Holy Communion:

- Please use the Communion Cloth (houseling cloth). Place both hands underneath the cloth and form a “tray” underneath.
- The communicant does not respond “Amen”.
- **Please do not** line up in front of the first pew to wait for the kneeling communicants to receive. Rather, wait in the main aisle and fill each spot that is emptied. This is for multiple reasons; one of them being to allow a greater ease of movement, most especially when there is more than one priest distributing Holy Communion.
