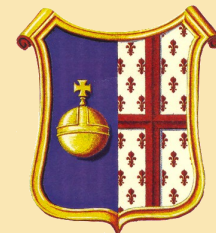

Saint Matthew

This Tuesday, September 21st, is the feast day of St. Matthew, apostle and evangelist. He is represented in our church by the symbol on the right hand end of the beam over the sanctuary. His symbol, the winged man, represents his writing about the human genealogy of Jesus and that we can use human reason to reach salvation.

St. Matthew was a tax collector when he was called to be an apostle by Our Lord. Some thought it wrong for Jesus to call a tax collector, but Jesus responded by saying that He came to call sinners. St. Matthew wrote the first gospel. He died a martyr's death, but the details are not clear.
