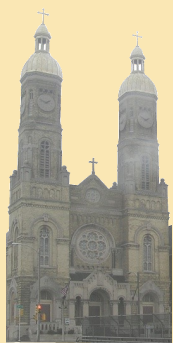
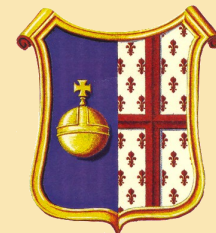

### **Queenship of Mary**

This Tuesday, May 31st, is the feast day of the Queenship of Mary. In our church, Our Lady, Queen of Heaven and Earth is represented by the center statue above the side altar on the Gospel side of the sanctuary. She is holding the baby Jesus.

The coronation of Mary is also represented in the rose window above the choir loft. It is the stained glass image in the center..

This feast was instituted by Pope Pius XII in 1954. He pointed out that Mary deserves the title because she is Mother of God, because she is closely associated as the New Eve with Jesus' redemptive work, because of her preeminent perfection, and because of her intercessory power.

### **WHO WAS AT PENTECOST?**

Pentecost Sunday is June 5th. When the Holy Ghost descended on the day of Pentecost, there was a large group gathered in the upper room, the cenacle. The apostles had added Matthias to their number. In addition, over 100 disciples were present along with the Blessed Virgin Mary and many of the other holy women who had followed Christ.

In our church, in addition to the dove of the Holy Ghost, we have statues and medallions of some who were present. On the rood beam over the sanctuary are the Blessed Virgin and St. John. In the row of symbols of the four evangelists we have St. Matthew and St. John. The medallion of St. Peter is over the sanctuary, on the right side.
