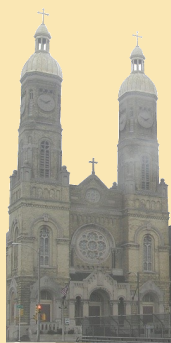

In 2021, the stained glass windows of the bell towers have been completed. Because their colors are much lighter than the previous glass and concrete windows, it has been necessary to soften the lighting inside the bell towers. If you see Saint Stanislaus church in the night, you will notice the difference since it has been done two weeks ago. We are now working on lighting up the rose window which is more complicated but not impossible.

Thanks to your motivated generosity during the Fundraising Dinner of May 19th, the exterior illumination project has started. It will be long because the city administration will be involved for the permit delivery. Everywhere in the world, administrations need time.

You might notice the Polish National Flag is flying next to the United States National Ensign on the church flag poles. The Polish flag will be flown for the year of our celebration of the 150th Anniversary of the construction of the church in honor of those Polish immigrants who sacrificed to build St. Stanislaus. We must be very grateful for the Polish Heritage of St. Stanislaus.
